Here Come the Holidays!

The holidays can be a real challenge for many of our clients, many of whom are unable to purchase food and gifts after paying bills. At Outreach we will be helping them make the holidays special for their families. With that in mind, we want to share three very special events that happen during the holiday season. If you'd like to donate funds, time or in-kind donations, give Outreach a call.

 Thanksgiving: Outreach provides food items to each family, enabling them to prepare a full Thanksgiving meal for

- their loved ones. Items include a turkey or ham, vegetables, mashed potatoes, stuffing, gravy, dinner rolls, butter, and a cake mix with frosting.
- Christmas Gift Cards: Each family receives a \$35 VISA gift card. They generally use the funds to purchase items for their Christmas dinner.
- Angel Tree Program: Each child aged 0

 17 receives gifts from donors.
 Children 12 and under receive a toy and clothing item and children 13 16
 receive a gift card. Gifts are wrapped and ready for families. If you'd like to participate in the Angel Tree, you can select a child or children beginning 11/4.
